CLSF offers ESL/Citizenship classes to prepare students for the USCIS Citizenship test. Students will perform mock interviews, study relevant American civics, and practice the English reading and writing portions of the test. For up to date class schedule visit centrolatinodesf.org.

Some of the activities CLSF offers include:


